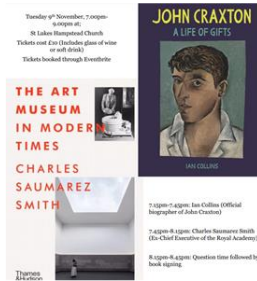
Save the date: Church House Party at High Leigh on 20th – 22nd May 2022
